**Vintage**

California's 2006 wine grape harvest started out cool and somewhat wet, saw heat spikes in July, and then cooled off for the remainder of the harvest season. The cool end allowed fruit flavors to develop slowly, and acids developed nicely.

Cassis, dark plum, sweet berry, with hints of saddle leather and eucalyptus.
