Vintage

A year of extremes : heavy rain in winter, early budbreak, severe frosts, extreme temperatures during bloom, strong winds in May, and smoke from wildfires in June created a harrowing year for growers, but warm days and cool nights in summer allowed the lighter crop to ripen without further trouble.

Vinification

This wine is made from 100% Chardonnay grapes, cool fermented in stainless steel tanks to retain optimum flavors and quality. After fermentation, a portion of the wines was aged in both French and American oak barrels.

Nicely balanced with a refreshing finish.

Pineapple, green apple, anise and slight vanilla

Palate

Juicy pear and Meyer lemon, with well balanced acidity.
