Vintage

The 2009 vintage was a relatively average year. It was mild throughout most of the season, punctuated by several short heat waves. The fruit was able to ripen fully to provide us with bright tropical fruit aromas and flavors.

Vinification

A long, cool, slow ferment in stainless steel tanks retained the bright varietal aromatics.

Overall Impression

Clean and refreshing, with juicy fruit.

Aroma

Forward pineapple, wet stone, lime, and Meyer lemon.

Palate

Pineapple and citrus, with juicy entry and lingering mineral note.
