#### Vintage

The 2009 vintage was a relatively average year. It was mild throughout most of the season, punctuated by several short heat waves. The fruit was able to ripen fully to provide us with bright tropical fruit aromas and flavors.

#### Vinification

This wine is made from 100% Zinfandel grapes, cool fermented in stainless steel tanks to retain optimum flavors and quality.

Nicely balanced with a refreshing finish.

##### Aroma

Dark plum, cherry and some sweet spice.

Jammy on the entry with even tannins and a sweet fruit finish.
