Vintage

A wet spring followed by a late start and long, cool growing season ending with a heat spike allowed grapes to reach maturity, with several regions reporting slightly lower sugars, higher acids and deep colors and flavors. The season was a balancing act with some winegrowers trimming fruit or pulling leaves to assure full fruit maturity. Regions reported lower to normal yields.

Winemaker's Notes

Overall Impression

Rich, ripe, and loaded with dark fruit.

Aroma

Dark fruit aromas of blackberry and black cherry with some sweet plum.

Palate

Bright fruit flavors of wild berries followed by a full mid-palate and a dark fruit finish. Easy drinking!

Beef short ribs, lamb, or anything grilled. Hard cheeses pair well or pasta dishes with a ragout sauce.
