**Vintage**

Early bud break set a course for an early harvest. A heat wave in late August and early September accelerated ripening, but was followed by a cool front and then warm, dry weather, allowing plenty of time for full development.

**Vinification**

Destemmed, crushed, and fermented on skins for 14 days. Pressed at dryness. Aged 20 months in French oak barrels.
